





Your Gateway to Member Resources

From tips for recruiting and maintaining new members to coming up with new ideas for community service projects, or from learning about how GFWC clubs operate to finding strategies to become a successful leader, the GFWC Member Portal Digital Library is truly a club president's gateway to essential member resources. By signing into your Member Portal account, you will automatically gain access to this vital source of information that will help enhance your membership experience.

Once you have signed into your [Member Portal account](#), you will be able to access the Digital Library by clicking on the profile icon in the upper right-hand corner of your screen and selecting "My Digital Library." If you do not see this option available, please email GFWC@GFWC.org and we will be happy to take a look at your account and see what we can do to help you get access to these valuable member resources (*please allow 12-24 hours to receive access after signing into your account*).



Once you are in the Digital Library, you can select the "Resources" folder. From there, you can either view the Index, which includes a list of the documents housed in the Digital Library and will help you quickly identify what folder to go to for the file you need, or you can choose to find the document by selecting the corresponding alphabetical folder.



For example, if you want to know more about what the Club Manual says in regard to GFWC's Community Service Programs, you will need to click on the "C" folder, followed by the "Club Manual" subfolder. From there, you will see a variety of additional sub folders and documents containing all of the information that makes up the Club Manual.
