

REQUIREMENTS AND DIRECTIONS FOR 2023 GCI DOUGLASS SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for the 2023 NJSFWC GCI Douglass Scholarship you must have:

- Attended and completed GCI 2022
- Been accepted to and committed to attending Rutgers University in 2023. Rutgers University must accept you before you can even apply to enter the Douglass Residential College Program.
 - Once you accept the offer of admission to Rutgers **and** formally commit to Rutgers by putting down your initial deposit, you will be given your Rutgers email and login information.
 - With this information, you will be able to log onto Rutgers' Enrollment Pathway website, which will give you all the next steps to prepare for your freshman year.
 - Here you will find a link to joining the Douglass Residential College
- Applied to and been accepted into the Douglass Residential College Program
- Complete and return the required application packet.
 - **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS BY JUNE 15, 2023**
 - Completed Application
 - Official Transcript(s): All high school transcripts to date.
 - Letters of Recommendation - Letters should be in a sealed envelope and included in your application packet. OR If you are asking the school and individuals who are recommending you send their letters directly to NJSFWC, you should provide a stamped, pre-addressed envelope. Those envelopes **MUST** include your name and "GCI scholarship application" on the *front bottom left corner* so that they can be easily matched to your packet.
 - At least one (1) Academic Letter of Recommendation from a member of the faculty where you attend school.
 - At least one (1) more Letter of Recommendation from any other person not related to you.
 - An Essay, as described.
 - Applicant's Name on top of each sheet,
 - maximum of two pages,
 - detailing your charitable endeavors, your future goals and your financial needs.
 - Attach the Essay Page to this application.
 - A self-addressed, stamped envelope (to be used to notify you of status after Scholarships are awarded).

*Items sent under separate cover **MUST** have the Applicants Name and GCI Scholarship clearly listed in the bottom left hand corner of the envelope, so they can be put with the correct application packet.

*Please follow up on transcripts and letters sent under separate cover; you will not be notified of items missing at the 6/15 deadline.
