MAR is pleased to be hosting the GFWC International President and President-elect for the inaugural GFWC National Day of Service on September 30, which will focus on food insecurity. No one can question the impact that this project will make when every GFWC club in the country will work to alleviate hunger in their communities.

MAR has registered to participate, with the targeted recipient Emmanuel Cancer Foundation the GFWC NJ Special State Project.

Since 1983, ECF has provided individualized services of all kinds to families with a child who has cancer ages newborn-18, regardless of race, creed, socioeconomic status, or any other demographic restriction. The families may receive assistance for as long as they need, whether it be one month or 10 years. There are no applications, forms, or other red tape for a family to deal with – ECF staff and volunteers strive to make the delivery of services as quick and seamless as possible. One of the important services is providing food assistance to their client families.

Members attending MAR are asked to donate \$10 gift cards from either Target or Walmart that will be donated to ECF to assist client families with food purchasing.

Please also plan to contribute to the collection of non-perishable food to be donated to the ECF food pantry.

An idea for members who are not attending MAR to participate in the GFWC National Day of Service could be to support the Region project early and send your donations via those who will travel to Atlantic City for the Conference weekend.
