The State Federation has been headquartered on the Douglass Residential Campus, formerly Douglass Women’s College at Rutgers University in New Brunswick, since 1966, and is a member of the General Federation of Women’s Clubs, the oldest and largest nonpartisan, nondenominational women’s volunteer service organization in the world. Opportunities are provided to women in education, leadership training and community service through participation in local clubs, enabling members to make a difference in the lives of others.

Today, NJSFWC is comprised of approximately 6,000 members in over **176** clubs throughout the state. The NJSFWC, a volunteer, community service organization, was founded in 1894. is headquartered on the Douglass College campus at Rutgers University in New Brunswick. The NJSFWC founded the New Jersey College for Women in 1918. In 2023, the organization, with a membership of over 6000, reported almost 63,476 community service projects involving over 632,368 volunteer hours and \$3.6 million in cash and in-kind donations. The NJSFWC is a member of the General Federation of Women’s Clubs (GFWC), which is headquartered in Washington, DC and is the largest and oldest women’s volunteer community service organization in the world.
