- F. Dues are due and payable with the submission of the “Yearbook Data Form aka the Blue Sheet” by May 1st.

Article III Sections 3.4 - A., B., F.

NOTE: - JUNIORETTE CLUBS (only)

The annual \$20.00 per capita dues (number reported by clubs for the Yearbook being the basis for dues) shall be payable by May 1, 2025. Annual State Federation dues of each Juniorette Club shall be the sum of ten dollars, plus GFWC (current per capita dues for GFWC are ten dollars for Junioresses).

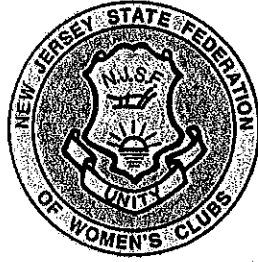

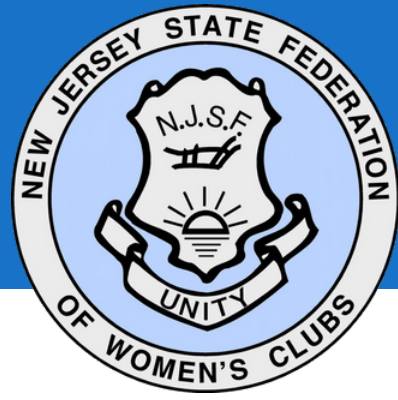
