### Legislation/Public Policy

#### Top Ten Projects 2024

1. The **Woman's Club of Madison** membership is active in their support of legislative issues in the state. Club members participated in a card writing campaign to Senators Booker and Representative Helmy re: S4516, and The Crime Victims Stabilization Act.
2. The **Millville Woman's Club** members contacted state and federal legislators on issues of social security solvency, and Medicaid resources. Then, through the GFWC Legislative Action Center, letters were sent on behalf of Victims of Sexual Assault, Expanding Caregiver Support for Veterans, Women's Suffrage Recognition, and Online Safety for Kids.
3. Members of the **Woman's Club of Denville Rockaway** made a targeted effort to increase enrollment in the Legislative Action Center. They were able to increase enrollment to 82% of the membership or 42 new people.
4. Members the **Haddon Fortnightly EMD** wrote letters, sent emails and made phone calls to local, state and national legislators in support of NJSFWC's and GFWC's legislative issues related to the advocacy for children, specifically the Freedom to Read Act and the Children's Vaccine Bill of Rights.
5. The members of the **Pines Lake Woman's Club** contacted 4 state and federal legislators on 15 different bills and laws and donated \$15,800 to 7 organizations that support human rights.
6. Members of the **Woman's Club of Belleville** enrolled 21 of their 36 members in the GFWC Legislative Action Center. They used the knowledge gained from that site to address a community issue effecting senior citizens, attending town meetings, setting meetings with legislators, and writing relevant ordinances.
7. Club members of the **Contemporary Club of Hasbrouck Heights** had an impact on local legislation by attending public hearings on issues of concern.
8. Letters were written by members of the **Women's Club of Absecon** in support of GFWC chosen issues.
9. Members of the **Woman's Club of Point Pleasant** supported 3 different issues with letters and emails to legislators.
10. Members **Woman's Club of West Milford** chose state and federal issues to support with a letter writing campaign to Senators Cory Booker and Bob Menendez and Congressman Josh Gottheimer, their local congressional representative.
