1. Official Transcripts

Submit all undergraduate transcripts and any graduate transcripts to date.

2. Academic Letter of Recommendation

Submit at least one letter from a faculty member from your undergraduate or graduate institution.

3. Additional Letter of Recommendation

Submit at least one additional letter from a non-family member.

4. Essay (Required)

Submit a typed essay, maximum two pages, double-spaced, not handwritten.

The essay should address the following:

- Charitable and community involvement
- Future goals
- Financial need

(Attach essay to application.)

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5. Contact for Notification

Provide either a self-addressed stamped envelope OR a valid email address for notification of results.
