What is it?

A Statewide Reading Initiative for NJSFWC Members and Clubs

The Education and Libraries Community Service Program is pleased to present the second year of Between the Pages! Women's Clubs can participate by registering their club reading groups OR individual members can participate. It will be a fun way for your club's book club or individual club members to read, and recommend books and receive a certificate for their participation.

Reading is a Force for Good!

Step One

Register to participate by sending your name, your club's Reading Group name, and District to Between The Pages Chairman Cheryl Dyer by email at dyer@njsfwc.org or by mail to Cheryl Dyer, 644 Princeton Ave, Brick, NJ 08724.

Step Two

Select a book from any genre and read it! You set the pace. As an individual participant or as a reading group participant you can read as many books as you want each month.

Write a Book Report!

Each month, fill out the Between the Pages report form with the name and title of the book and a 50 word review of the books you have read that month.

Use the Between the Pages reporting form found on the website. The form can be snail mailed, emailed or use the fillable report form.

Club Reading Groups only need to send in one form for each book the group reads. Please designate one person from the group to act as representative.

Recognition

Certificates will be awarded to the club's Reading Group and to those registered as individual members. The categories for certificates are:

- Scholar: 1-10 books read
- Honors: 11-20 books read
- Elite: 21 and over books read

The Between the Pages reading time frame will be September 15, 2026 through March 15, 2027.

Note- This is not part of the GFWC NSO program.
